C G7 C  
 When the RRRobin comes BBBobbin' along, along;  
 C G7 C C7  
 There'll be no more sobbing when he starts throbbin' his old, sweet song.

F Fm C Am  
 Wake up, wake up, you sleepy head; get up, get up, get out of bed  
 D7 G7/ Gdim/ Dm G7  
 Cheer up, cheer up, the sun is red: Live, love, laugh & be happy!

C G7 C  
 What if I've been blue? Now I'm walkin' through fields of flowers.  
 C G7 C C7  
 Rain may glisten, but still I'll listen for hours, and hours.

F Fm C Adim  
 I'm just a kid again, doing what I did again, singin' a song;  
 C G7 C (play C with pinky to easily shape Adim)  
 When the RRRobin comes BBBobbin' along.

Repeat from the top, then,  
 Outro:

C G7 C// Adim// C/ Adim/ C/
