**Intro:** G/ Bm/ Bb/ Bb/ Am//// D7////  
To lead a better life, I need my love to be here;

G Am Bm C G Am  
Here, making each day of the year,  
Bm C F#m B7  
Changing my life with a wave of her hand,  
F#m B7 Em Am7 Am D7  
Nobody can, deny that there's something there;  
G Am Bm C G Am  
There, running my hand through her hair,  
Bm C F#m B7  
Both of us thinking how good it can be,  
F#m B7 Em Am7 Am F7/  
Someone is speaking, but she doesn't know he's there;  
F7/ Bb Gm  
I want her everywhere,  
Cm D Gm////  
and if she's beside me I know I need never care.
