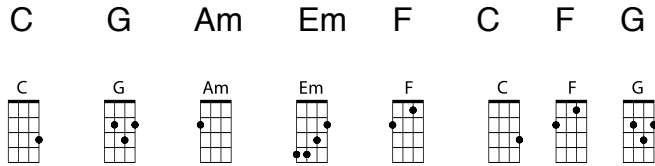


PACHELBEL CANON IN C, a fun exercise (based on Canon in D)

We'll divide into four groups. Each group uses the following chords in the order given, 4 beats per chord.



Each group will be assigned one of the following parts:

- 1) **Strum** single strum on 1st beat: strum 2,3,4 strum 2,3,4 strum 2,3,4 strum 2,3, 4
- 2) **Arpeggiate** each chord: one pluck per string: 4,3,2,1=4 beats (G string, C string, E string, A string)

* Group 3 and Group 4 play simultaneously in this arrangement.

3)* Pluck following tabs (each pluck gets 4 beats):

A string	3 - - - 2 - - - 0 - - -		0 - - -		0 - - - 2 - - -
E string			3 - - -		3 - - -

4)* Pluck following tabs (each pluck gets 4 beats):

A string	7 - - - 5 - - - 3 - - - 2 - - - 0 - - -				
E string			3 - - - 1 - - - 3 - - -		

The leader will lead in with the count: **1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4**, then direct **Grp 1** players to begin. When **Grp 1** ends, **Grp 2** enters. When **Grp 2** ends, **Grp 3** and **Grp 4** enter.

All players **repeat their parts 4 more times.**

Here's a cheat sheet to help keep track of your 4 repeats:

1. C G Am Em F C F G
2. C G Am Em F C F G
3. C G Am Em F C F G
4. C G Am Em F C F G

Reverse flow. Groups 3 and 4 drop out; the rest play another round of chords. Group 2 drops out; Group 1 plays another round of chords, then **All end on a triumphant strum of C!**
